Whitehill-Bordon is one of four towns in England which has been designated as an eco-town. We have been given funding to deliver a sustainable and exemplary eco-development which will pilot some of the foremost technologies of the day as well as becoming a focus for green innovation.

The Whitehill-Bordon Opportunity Project is managed by East Hampshire District Council, but is a partnership between all levels of local government, Natural England, MoD, SEEDA and the Homes and Communities Agency.

You will be responsible for leading on Biodiversity and Environment, one of the five eco-town themes for the delivery of the Whitehill Bordon eco-town programme. As well as being an expert in one of the specialisms, you will manage relationships with relevant experts within statutory agencies and external consultants ensuring they contribute to the delivery of the themes.
